Good afternoon SEQ clubs,

Current information available has Tropical Cyclone Alfred crossing the southeast Queensland coast between Brisbane and the Gold Coast on Thursday evening. Government updates can be followed [here](#).

There will be increasing impacts from Thursday morning so there is still a small window to ensure your venue is as prepared as possible. Racing Queensland strongly encourages clubs to utilise the Queensland Government's [Cyclone and storm surge preparation checklist](#) previously provided if still in a position to do so safely.

Further to this, clubs should also consider:

- laying down rail;
- moving machinery and equipment to higher ground or indoors;
- securing loose items; and
- notifying trainers if facilities are closed.

Additionally, it is really important for safety that clubs undertake an inspection prior to reopening which may include inspections by suitably qualified trades (e.g. electricians or builders) and PPE worn if contamination has occurred.

Ultimately, the safety of staff, volunteers and participants should be of the highest priority.
